There is an opening reception free to the public on Friday, March 4th from 6 to 8 pm at the newly opened Brush Studio, located downtown at 50 Louis SW, Grand Rapids, MI. The show runs from March 4 to March 16 and is open for viewing during Brush Studio's business hours (Tues & Wed 10 – 5, Thurs – Sat 10 – 9).
